RENEW IN 2022

Kick off — March 20, 2022.

Scope:

Transformation of AUMC physical plant atmosphere to support the refreshed mission statement "Connecting people with the love and life of Jesus Christ for the Transformation of the world".

- Replace 34 year old Carpeting in Sanctuary, 2 adjanct storage rooms, Narthex, Parlor and Elevator Hallway
- Paint Coat Room, South Entrance, Sanctuary, Narthex,
 Parlor including paneling and cupboards, Elevator
 Hallway
- Remove Pews and utilize some oak for Sanctuary stairs to alter and sell the remaining pews to AUMC congregation \$100 each or Facebook Marketplace \$250 each. 21 large pews, 8 small pews
- Replace pews with flexible seating chairs-for a modern worship environment.

Goal is to raise \$45,000 for this project.
