FINANCIAL UPDATE

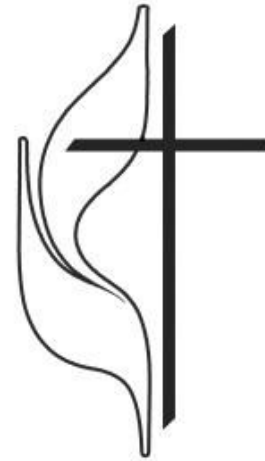
